Three actions you can take to help manage the spread

- 3. **Stay home if you are unwell** and in schools, send home staff or students who show signs of being unwell through the day.

If students become unwell at school we will be calling parents and carers to collect them. Our school executive will be meeting this afternoon to consider measures that we will be implementing locally to help maintain a safe, yet viable school environment.
