Dear Families,

Our school continues to operate and hopefully we are going to be able to use some of the quiet conditions to our advantage. Gillieston Public School is due for some maintenance work targeting the Library, parts of the Old Admin Building, and two of our classrooms. I am very hopeful that these considerable tasks may be completed during the holidays or whilst the school is quiet due to the ongoing restrictions.

There will be new carpet placed into two classrooms with both rooms also gaining an interior paint.
